The universe is big. This week is bigger.



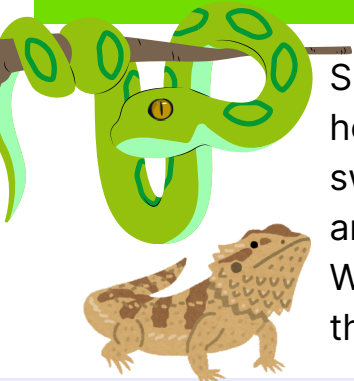
July 27th - July 31st

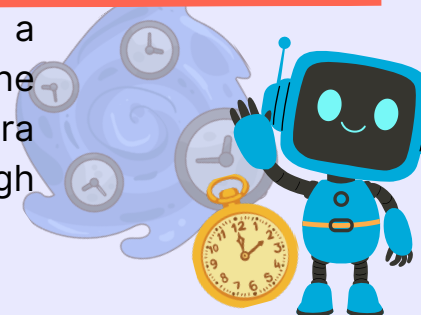

Payment Information

Bulldog offers the following payment structure to help keep your summer stress-free and organized:

Weekly Deposit

A \$50 non-refundable deposit is required to secure camp spaces. This commitment allows us to start planning, nail down numbers and purchase supplies in advance.

Remaining Balance

Choose the Payment Plan to have the remaining camp fees automatically charged four weeks prior to each camp's start date.

Subsidized Families

If you have already been approved for subsidy and have a current Notice of Eligibility for Summer 2026 outlining a daily parent rate of less than \$10, please email our Camp Coordinator (olivia@barriebulldog.com) to discuss deposit and payment structure prior to registering.

A \$100 refundable hold will be charged and remain on file for the summer. It will be refunded, less any accrued fees for the season after your child(ren)'s last week at camp.
